Indefinite Pronouns

Zaimki nieokreślone stanowią dość niejednorodną grupę wyrazów. Niektóre z nich występują także w roli określników tj. łącznie z rzeczownikami. Wyrazy *some, any, none* oraz złożenia utworzone z wyrazami *some, any, no, every* można zestawić w następujący sposób.

<i>some, any</i> - trochę <i>somebody, anybody</i> - ktoś <i>someone, anyone</i> - ktoś <i>something, anything</i> - coś	↔	<i>none</i> - żaden <i>nobody</i> - nikt <i>no one</i> - nikt <i>nothing</i> - nic	↔	<i>Everybody</i> - każdy, wszyscy <i>Everyone</i> - każdy, wszyscy <i>Everything</i> - wszystko
---	---	---	---	---

Przykłady:

- - **Somebody, anybody** -
We must find somebody(someone) to help us.
(Musimy znaleźć kogoś, aby nam pomógł.
- - **Nobody, no one** -
We can find nobody(no one) to help us.
Nie możemy znaleźć nikogo, żeby nam pomógł.
- - **Everybody, everyone** -
Everybody(everyone) can learn a foreign.
Każdy może nauczyć się obcego języka.
